PREZODE EUROPE workshop #2
October 28, 2021 – 9:00-12:00 am CET

The European workshops of PREZODE are part of a series of regional workshops that will support the co-design of PREZODE's scientific strategy and contribute to the international strategic agenda of the initiative. Each workshop will have a regional perspective that will be integrated in the global action plan of PREZODE.

These workshops have the following objectives:

- **To discuss and share a common vision** of scenarios in which pandemic risks would be minimized, especially through an improved prevention of zoonotic disease emergence.
- **To identify unmet needs for research and knowledge** aligned with PREZODE's sought-after goals,
- **To create scientific and societal momentum and federate a community of research scientists and of stakeholders.**

Three European PREZODE workshops are held in 2021 as follows:

- Workshop 1 with scientists – July 6, 2021 discussed the vision of PREZODE and the transformations corresponding to this vision as seen by the participants as well as to identify scientific frontiers, the European specificities and their link to transformations;
- Workshop 2 with stakeholders – October 28, 2021 aims to discuss among stakeholders these transformations on the basis of the synthetic restitution of Workshop 1, to complete them and identify the actions necessary to achieve them (innovation, training, support for public policies) and the potential trade-offs.
- Workshop 3 – November / December 2021 (TBD) with all the actors (scientific community and stakeholders) will compare and integrate the lessons from two previous workshops and propose key elements for a strategic European research agenda and an operational roadmap.
